ToR, Scope of Work of Network Planning Group (NPG) and Role of BISAG-N

- The group will be responsible for sharing their specific Action Plans for 2020-21 to 2024-25 with each other for facilitating integration of networks, enhance optimization through modification/expansion/new network creation to avoid duplication of works for holistic development of any region as well as reducing logistics costs through micro-plan detailing.
- 2. This group shall after examining all the interventions proposed to be taken by various synchronization of efforts are -Ministries will delineate all projects where required and propose any changes in the PM GatiShakti NMP for consideration and approval of the EGoS.
- 3. The Network Planning Group will also examine the following proposals which are not forming part of the Master Plan currently:
 - i. Projects of Infrastructure connectivity Ministries which are costing more than Rs. 500 crore included under multimodal infrastructure classification, where DPRs have either · been completed or in advanced stage;
 - ii. ... All major new connectivity / network proposals of Infrastructure connectivity Ministries involving cost of more than Rs 500 crore or those that are vital or critical from multimodal connectivity point of view to be so determined by the Logistics Division/NPG;
 - . Further, NPG may also recommend critical multimodal connectivity project proposals which are even not recommended by any line Ministry to ensure proper integration and may also examine projects with reference to tourism development.
 - The nodal officers of the concerned Ministry/Department will be responsible to ensure that the data inputs of the progress pertaining to the respective Ministry have been correctly mapped in the PM GatiShakti NMP through the individual applications provided by BISAG-N.
 - 5. In order to avoid duplication of procurement and processing of the high-resolution satellite images from National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC), one of the primary centres of Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), Department of Space (DOS), BISAG-N will be the sole agency to procure this for the platform (PM GatiShakti NMP) and would be facilitated by the Logistics Division.
 - 6. Geo spatial data of each stakeholder using this platform will be developed on these images.
 - 7. This portal will provide consolidated view & enable review of all projects through a dashboard and Project management module of various organisations.
 - 8. It is through this GIS platform-based system, NPG will monitor all the interventions in the Master Plan propare periodic reports review by the EGoS on the implementation.
 - 9. Will assist EGoS in coordinating for any changes in the projects already included in the Master Plan. While close coordination with the State Governments will be done, private sector industries, experts will also be closely associated and consulted during planning
